COURT NOTICE/ORDER/RULING

Upon review of the files in these cases, the Court identifies the following pleadings which must be addressed.

1. Objection to Subpoena Duces Tecum, filed on May 16, 2008, by counsel for the Court-Appointed Special Fiduciary of the United Effort Plan Trust.
2. Defendant's Motion to Quash Subpoena Duces Tecum filed on June 9, 2008.

These pleadings both address a Subpoena Duces Tecum issued by the Clerk's Office dated May 9, 2008, directing Jeffery Shields, who is identified in the pleadings as counsel for the Special Fiduciary of the Trust, to provide to the Mohave County Attorney's Office certain items apparently seized from the Defendant's vehicle on August 28, 2006, in the state of Nevada. That Subpoena Duces Tecum, as is usually the case, was signed or stamped by a deputy clerk and was not signed or otherwise authorized by this Court in its judicial capacity.

3. State's Objection to Defendant's Public Records Request filed on May 21, 2008.
4. Defendant's Reply to Objection to Defendant's Public Records Request filed on June 5, 2008.

These pleadings both address a request made in writing by counsel for the Defendant dated May 1, 2008, and directed to the Arizona Attorney General's Office requesting release to defense counsel of certain items believed to be in their possession. The pleading by the State indicates that the Arizona Attorney General's Office has declined to honor that request. However, that pleading was filed by Mr. Linnis, identified as a Special Deputy County Attorney. It is not immediately clear to the Court whether that pleading is being filed in his capacity as a prosecutor in this case for the Mohave County Attorney's Office, in his capacity as legal counsel for the Arizona Attorney General's Office or both. It is also not clear to the Court that, assuming the request has been denied already, there is an issue specifically framed by the pleadings requiring a ruling by this Court.

IT IS ORDERED setting these matters for hearing on the above motions, to the extent still relevant, on Friday, July 11, 2008, at 1:30 p.m.
