COMES NOW, Plaintiff Pro Per, NANCY KNIGHT, hereby requests an extension of time to comply with the Proposed Order signed by the Hon. Judge Jantzen on or about February 17, 2023. Knight has not been provided the Summons, Waiver of Service Form and Acceptance of Service form for her compliance with a deadline of 150 days from the signed Order that will cause dismissal of this case on or about July 15, 2023.



Knight pleads with this Court to either grant Knight the more appropriately worded Proposed Order filed by Knight on May 15, 2023 in her "Motion for Reconsideration of Final Orders for Service on Indispensable Parties Dated Feb. 17, 2023 for Inappropriate Content and Failure of the Court to Provide the Summons and Waiver of Service Form" or grant Knight an extension of time of 150 days from Knight's receipt of the Summons, Waiver of Service, and the additional Acceptance of Service forms from the Clerk of Mohave County Superior Court.

Granting the Motion for Reconsideration is preferred since it also protects the interests of the indispensable parties. Pro per plaintiffs and defendants are not required to suffer the costs of electronic filing and the learning curve associated with TurboCourt submissions therefore those of us in Desert Lakes take our paper documents to the clerk at the Bullhead City Courthouse.

MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

Pursuant to Rule 7.1(e) (1) Generally, A party seeking reconsideration of a court order or ruling may file a motion for reconsideration. Pursuant to Rule 6 (b)(1) When an act may or must be done within a specified time, the court may, for good cause, extend the time: (A) with or without motion or notice if the court acts, or the request is made, before the original time or its extension expires.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Plaintiff Knight has not failed a duty and she needs the full 150 days from when all Service Packet materials are provided by the Court that in the absence of the revised Proposed Order submitted by Knight on May 15, 2023 will now need the additional

Acceptance of Service Form to be provided by the Clerk of the Court.

There exists a potential of 400 or more interested parties that will be affected by the language in the Summons, Waiver of Service Form and Acceptance of Service Form. It is a moving target because the current owners, when Knight created the spreadsheet for the Clerk last year, changed with sales that when made in cash are not even listed by the County Recorder and it takes time for the Assessor to post the tax statement to find the name of the current owners and their mailing address.

It is important for the Summons to inform the Indispensable Parties of their responsibility to update their email address or be responsible for costs of postal mailing.

The duty of the Court in conjunction with Christine Spurlock, Clerk of the Court, is to compose the language for a Notice to the Parties (aka Summons - I assume), and language for the Waiver of Service Form and Acceptance of Service Form. Boilerplates for pleadings do not conform to the needs of this Rule 19 process.

An Order for the Court's signature for one of two choices is filed with the clerk.
