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filed concurrently on August 15, 2023;

- C. Plaintiff's "Amended Notice to Property Owners" filing date unknown, however, transmitted electronically to the undersigned on or about August 20, 2023 (hereinafter referenced as "Plaintiff's Proposed Notice #2") and allegedly transmitted to the Clerk of the Court on August 21, 2023, and/or August 23, 2023; and, finally
- D. Plaintiff's third apparent "Notice to Property Owners" that appears to have been appended to a document captioned "Notice of Plaintiff's Revision to Notice of Property Owners" dated August 25, 2023 (hereinafter referenced as "Plaintiff's Proposed Notice #3").

Thereafter, the undersigned transmitted to the Plaintiff electronically a multi-page letter requesting Plaintiff's withdrawal of each of the subject documents and advising the Plaintiff that the statements, allegations, purported facts and materials, individually and collectively, represent materials and pleadings that are redundant, immaterial, impertinent and/or scandalous, all categories of which are throughout the subject documents and in specific, direct and acute violation of Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure Rule 12(f). The subject request to withdraw those subject documents in their entirety was transmitted electronically to the Plaintiff on August 30, 2023 at 4:33 p.m.

Thereafter, Plaintiff responded to the undersigned on Thursday, August 31, 2023, at 6:54 p.m. The Plaintiff's electronic transmittal made it abundantly and absolutely clear that the Plaintiff would not withdraw any of the documents or any parts thereof reiterating as is stated such false and erroneous statements including that the Defendants in this matter have transitioned to the role of plaintiffs and that Plaintiff has now been transposed and become the defendant as is succinctly set forth in Plaintiff's Waiver of Service form and proposed Summons to be served on the Rule 19 parties if service is via an "Acceptance" format.

Thereafter, the undersigned reached out to the Plaintiff telephonically on Monday, September 4, 2023, and again asked that Plaintiff voluntarily withdraw the pleadings and discussed or pointed out to Plaintiff why and Plaintiff's fact allegations were clearly erroneous, false and that the Plaintiff cannot literally change the parties' positions of plaintiff versus defendant and who brought the action that is resulting in the Rule 19 parties being brought before the Court. The undersigned found no willingness to withdraw the documents
