Plaintiff has filed a "Motion to Compel Defendant's Notice of Transcript Order Dated on or about April 3, 2018" requesting that this Court "Compel the Defendants to file a Notice of Transcript Order for reference in a Supplement to the Index of Record." See, Plaintiff's 02/10/2024 Motion, p. 1, lines 19.5 - 21.

First of all, this matter is the subject matter of an appeal to the Arizona Court of Appeals, Division One, Plaintiff's Notice of Appeal having been filed on January 16, 2024. As such, this Court is without jurisdiction to compel the Defendants to take the requested action. Further, under and pursuant to Rule 11 of the Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure, the Appellant is the responsible party to order transcripts of the Superior Court proceedings not already in the official record. More specifically, Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure, Rule 11(c), in pertinent part, reads as follows:

1	"c) Appellant's Duty to Order Transcripts and Other Parties' Transcript Designations.
2	(1) What to Order.
3   4	(A) The appellant must order transcripts of superior court proceedings not already in the official record that the appellant deems necessary for proper consideration of
5	the issues on appeal.
6	(B) If the appellant will contend on appeal that a judgment, finding or conclusion, is unsupported by the
7 8	evidence or is contrary to the evidence, the appellant must include in the record transcripts of all proceedings containing evidence relevant to that judgment, finding or
9	conclusion.
10	(C)"
11	Plaintiff's request is also untimely and therefore void pursuant to Arizona Rules of
12	Civil Appellate Procedure, Rule 11(c)(2) which reads as follows:
13	"The appellant must order transcripts directly from a certified reporter or an authorized transcriber within 10 days after filing the notice of appeal"
14	of all authorized transcriber within 10 days after filling the horice of appear
15	The subject 10 days has long since expired.
16	Similarly, pursuant to Arizona Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure Rule 11(c)(3), if
17	in fact Plaintiff intended the subject Motion to be a Rule 11(c)(3) "Notice" motion, once
18	again, the subject Motion or Notice dated February 10, 2024, is delinquent and well beyond
19	the Rule 11(c)(3) fifteen (15) days after filing the Notice of Appeal.
20	Plaintiff's Motion simply cannot be addressed by this Court as it is outside the Court's
21	jurisdiction.
