Rule 59(b) provides that a motion for a new trial "may be amended at any time before the court rules on it." Pursuant to Rule 59(b), Contestants file this Amended Motion for New Trial. This amendment simply supplements the previous original Motion on a point that was made in that original Motion, and thus the original Motion is incorporated by reference.

Contestants referenced the hand count that occurred pursuant to the recount under A.R.S. Section 16-663. By law this recount encompasses 5% of the precincts. *Id.* There were four counties that included the Attorney General's race and had a discrepancy between the handcount and the machine count, and the net effect of these discrepancies revealed the following net change in vote totals:

So in other words, this would be a gain of seven votes for Mr. Hamadeh over a small sample (and would undoubtedly increase over a larger size, 140 net votes for Mr. Hamadeh

1	in the same trend prevaned), but the statute, which was not written for a race in which		
2	statewide candidates are separated by 280 votes, does not provide for an adjustment. ¹		
3 4	This means that Mr. Hamadeh's vote total is likely understated by approximately		
5	140 votes. Additionally, for the reasons set forth in the Motion for a New Trial, it is also		
6	likely that the limited partial hand count failed to identify discrepancies caused by machines		
7	erroneously reading votes for Mr. Hamadeh as undervotes – leading to his vote total being		
8	even more understated. ²

17	Therefore, no additional votes were factored into the total for Hamadeh as a result of the		
18	entitioning, interrespondent only conducted a mand country of the country		
19	centers and 2% of early ballots, despite the statutory requirement of conducting a hand count on "five percent of the precincts for the recounted race for hand count" (A.R.S. §		
20 21	16-663(B)), but the total number of Election Day ballots hand counted for the Attorney General's race was a meager 2,406 ballots out of 248,070 Election Day ballots verified		
22	and counted (or just 0.96%). Exhibit A (Maricopa County Hand Count & Audit Report); see also https://apps.azsos.gov/election/files/2022_General_Canvass_Maricopa_1.pdf		
23	(Maricopa County November General Election Canvass which reports that 248,070 Election Day ballots were verified and counted) (last accessed Jan 4, 2023).		
24	Comparatively, Maricopa County hand counted 31,201 early ballots for the recount (although that was still only 2% of early votes despite a statutory requirement of 5%).		
25	Given the tabulation errors exclusively occurred on Election Day, hand counting less than 1% of Election Day ballots (especially from two vote centers (First Baptist Church-		
26 27	Chandler and Desert Oasis Aquatic Center) that did not have significant problems with rejected ballots) was not likely a large enough sample set to identify discrepancies,		
28	especially as it relates to undervotes. <i>See also</i> Exhibit G to original Motion (identifying First Baptist Church as having 116 rejected ballots and Desert Oasis as having 293).
