**BALLOT INSPECTOR COMPENSATION
REQUEST**

Pursuant to this Court's Order dated August 31, 2023, undersigned counsel for the Navajo County Defendants hereby submits the following specific request for compensation for ballot inspectors. This is based upon the State minimum wage of \$13.85 per hour for each ballot inspector and the state-approved mileage compensation rate of 62.5 cents per mile:

Bowen Udall (Court Inspector) 7 hours, 116 miles roundtrip

\$13.85 per hour = \$96.95
116 miles @ 62.5¢ per mile = \$72.50

Total: \$169.45

Missa Foy (Inspector for Abe Hamadeh) 8 hours, 108 miles roundtrip

\$13.85 per hour = \$110.80
108 miles @ 62.5¢ per mile = \$67.50

\$178.30

Lisa Green (Inspector for Kris Mayes) 9.5 hours, 100 miles roundtrip

\$13.85 per hour = \$131.75
100 miles @ 62.5¢ per mile = \$ 62.50

\$194.25

The total compensation for Navajo County's three ballot inspectors is \$542.00. A proposed order approving the same has been submitted for the Court's approval along with this claim.
