To the: Honorable Judge Jantzen,

I recently became aware of a decision you will be making soon regarding the mailing in of election ballots.

I am extremely concerned about this and feel the need to offer my voice, mainly because I feel I am about to lose that voice, should the desires of the AZ Republican Party come to fruition. I have been a lifelong member of the Republican Party and voted in every election for over 40 years... until 2020... Also, for reference, I have voted by mail for every election since 1988.

I am appalled at what I see taking place as I watch our democracy and freedoms being systematically eliminated.

Please take into consideration the following situations...

- 1- Senior citizens and handicapped individuals may not be physically able to go to a polling location mail in ballots are necessary
- 2- Health care workers and teachers may not be able to go to a polling location due to scheduling conflicts mail in ballots aid in voting for these citizens
