# **INSTRUCTIONS: HOW TO SERVE THE COURT PAPERS BY PUBLICATION**

# STEP 1: FILL OUT AND FILE THE Declaration of Due Diligence and Request for Alternate Means of Service (Publication):

- **A.** Wait to see if the court gives you permission to do service by publishing. The court will send you their decision in the mail.
- **B.** Once you obtain permission from the court to do service by publishing, proceed to Step 2.

**NOTE:** If you know the last known address of the person you need to serve, you must, on or before the first date of publication of the legal notice, mail the person the *Summons* and copy of the court paperwork you filed. Standard mail, postage prepaid is acceptable.

## STEP 2: PUBLISH THE LEGAL NOTICE:

Service by publishing is accomplished by publishing the *Summons*, and a statement describing how a copy of the pleading being served may be obtained, at least once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks.

A. You will need to have the legal notice published in a newspaper in Mohave County.

#### AND

- **B.** If the last known address of the other party is in a different county/state, you will also need to have the legal notice published in a newspaper in that county. (If there is no newspaper published in the county where publication is required, you will have the legal notice published in an adjoining county that does have a newspaper.)
- **C.** Service is complete **30** days after the summons and statement are first published in all newspapers where publication is required.

# STEP 3: FILE PROOF OF PUBLISHING:

- **A.** The newspaper will send you a document which provides a copy of your legal notice and the dates it was published in the newspaper. You should receive this approximately 4-5 weeks after your legal notice is published.
- **B.** Once you receive the document from the newspaper, file it and the completed *Affidavit* of *Publishing* with the court. Make sure to make a copy of both to keep for your records.

## STEP 4: COUNT:

- A. Find the date the other party was served by publication by locating the first date the legal notice was published in the newspaper. Then, count the days for the other party to file a Response or Answer. When counting the days, start counting with the day <u>after</u> the first day of publication.
- **B.** If the other party fails to file a Response or Answer **30** calendar days after the first day of publication, you may wish to look into filing for DEFAULT. Information on DEFAULT can be obtained online at <u>www.mohavecourts.az.com</u> or by contacting the Law Library
