- 1. Filing this application today with the Court does not necessarily mean the Court has jurisdiction to modify or enforce this out-of-state order.
- 2. For an Arizona Court to have power to modify (change) another state's court order, the minor child must have lived with a parent or a person acting as a parent in Arizona for at least six consecutive months prior to the filing of the Petition to Modify **AND** either:
 - <u>All parties must have moved from the state where the order was issued</u>, OR
 - The court where the order was issued determines that it no longer has jurisdiction to modify the order or that Arizona would be a more convenient forum.
- 3. The forms in this packet only apply to registering legal decision-making, patenting time, or nonparent visitation orders from another state.

READ ME: Consulting a lawyer before filing documents with the court may help prevent unexpected results.

Your oath or affirmation on this Affidavit that the information provided is true and correct to the best of your knowledge and belief applies to the extra page(s) as well.
- You are also required to list the <u>current</u> address of any adult with whom any child named in the order lived over the past five years **unless**:
 - 1. that information is not already known to other parties, AND
 - 2. that information would endanger those persons or someone else if made public or included with documents to be served on (delivered to) other parties in the case.

If **BOTH** 1 and 2 above apply, write "Protected" in the space provided for the address and supply that information on the **Request for Protected Address** form available from the or the website.

REGARDING 2, 3, and 4 (below): Space is provided to describe only <u>one</u> other legal or physical custodyrelated case, <u>one</u> other non-legal or physical custody-related case or proceeding, and <u>one</u> non-party person (or agency) who claims rights regarding one or more children named in the other state's order, **if there is more than one:**

- Check the box at the bottom of each section to indicate you are supplying the same information as required for that section on extra pages, which should be considered part of this Affidavit.
- Give the added pages the same title as the section for which you are supplying the additional information, for example "Other Cases you participated as a party, a witness . . . " etc.
- Your oath or affirmation on the Affidavit that the information provided is true and correct applies to the extra page(s) as well.
- 2. OTHER COURT CASES YOU PARTICIPATED AS A PARTY, A WITNESS OR OTHERWISE IN ANY MATTER THAT ADDRESSED YOUR LEGAL DECISION-MAKING, PARENTING TIME, or NON-PARENT VISITATION involving any minor named in the other state's order (other than the case which resulted in the other state's order).

Check "Yes" or "No" to indicate whether there are other court cases as described above. If "yes", read carefully and provide the information requested.

- 3. ANY DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, PROTECTIVE ORDER, TERMINATION OF PARENTAL RIGHTS AND ADOPTIONS INVOLVING ANY OF THE PARTIES IN THE CASE YOU ARE SEEKING TO REGISTER. Check "Yes" or "No" to indicate whether there are other any cases or proceedings like the cases listed.
- 4. ANY OTHER PERSON WHO HAS, PHYSICAL CUSTODY OF OR NON-PARENT VISITATION WITH THE CHILDREN LISTED. Check "Yes" or "No" to indicate whether there are persons other than those listed in the other state's order who claim a right to physical custody or non-parent visitation of any minor named in that order. Use the space provided to list those persons' names and (if not protected) addresses. Briefly explain why each believes he or she has or should have rights concerning any child named in the other state's order. For example you could simply list their relation to the child or children, such as "grandparent", or state that one or more of the children lived with that individual for some period of time.

STEP 2. MAKE 2 COPIES (or more, if more than one other party is involved) of the following:

- Request to Register letter
- Affidavit to Register Foreign Custody Order
- Affidavit Regarding Minor Children (along with any extra pages)
- The out-of-state foreign order(s) being registered.

STEP 3. SEPARATE YOUR DOCUMENTS INTO 3 SETS* (or More, if additional parties)

*If more than one other adult (or agency) is listed as a party in the order being registered, you will need to make an additional set of the documents listed in Set 3 for each party.

STEP 4. FILE YOUR PAPERS WITH THE CLERK OF COURT.

Go to the Clerk of the Court's Filing Counter. Hand over the originals, all sets of copies, and the filing fee or **Fee Deferral Application** to the Clerk at the filing counter.

Court is open Monday through Friday, except holidays. You may file at any of the following court locations.

FEES: There is a filing fee to register another state's court order regarding matters of legal decisionmaking, parenting time, or non-parent visitation in Arizona. If you cannot afford the filing fee, you may obtain the (free) application for fee deferral or waiver from any Superior Court location or from the online.

The Clerk will:

- Assign a new Mohave County case number,
- Review the Fee Deferral Application (if applicable).
- Keep the originals and all but one set of copies,
- Stamp the extra copies to indicate they conform to (are the same as) documents filed with the Court, *and*
- Return one set of stamped ("conformed") copies for you to keep for your records.

NOTE: For purposes of *enforcement*, a legal decision-making, parenting time or non-parent visitation order is registered <u>when filed</u> (A.R.S. § 25-1055), and may be immediately enforced in the same manner as an order issued by a court of this state. However, no court of this state may *modify* (change) that order if the issuing court still has jurisdiction (A.R.S. §§ 25-1033, 1056).

AFTER YOU FILE:

- The Court will notify the non-registering party of your request to register the other state's order in Arizona. Notice will include copies of orders involved and related documents.
- The party receiving notice has **twenty (20) days** to request a hearing to object or otherwise respond to the order being registered in Arizona.

If a non-registering party requests a hearing, the Court will notify all parties of the date, time and place of the hearing.

STEP 5 (A). IF THERE IS A HEARING: GO. If a conference and hearing have been scheduled, be sure to write down the date, time and place, and attend the hearing.

Be on time.
 Dress neatly.
 Do not bring children to court.

A party disputing the validity or enforcement of a registered order or seeking to vacate (cancel) the registration has the burden of proving one or more of the defenses listed in **A.R.S. § 25-1055 (D)**.

WHAT THE COURT WILL DO:

If a party presents evidence establishing a full or partial defense, the Court may:

- Stay (halt or prevent) enforcement of the registered order,
- Continue the proceeding to permit introduction of additional relevant evidence,
- Enforce the uncontested parts of the order.

If the contesting party does not establish a defense to the validity of the order itself or to enforcement of the order, the Court will issue an order confirming the order. A.R.S. § 25-1055(D).

STEP 5 (B). IF THERE IS NO HEARING.

If no request for hearing is made within 20 days, in accord with A.R.S. § 25-1055 (D) and (E),

- 1. Registration will be confirmed by operation of law (automatically),
- 2. Later attempts to dispute any matter that could have been brought up will be barred, and
- 3. The Court will notify the person who requested registration and all other parties previously served of the confirmation.

NOTICE: Once registration is confirmed, whether after notice and hearing or by operation of law because no party requested a hearing to dispute it, later attempts to dispute any matter that could have been brought up at the time of registration are barred. A.R.S. § 25-1055 (F).

Once registration is confirmed, the order may be enforced as if issued by a court of this state. However, you must file forms to request enforcement, which may be found at any or online.

Separate requirements apply however, for this state to be able to **change** the order. If you want to modify the registered order, see **A.R.S. § 25-1033** and the other statutes it mentions to help determine whether Arizona may now or in the future have jurisdiction to modify the order, or consult an Arizona licensed attorney for advice.
