(CHECKLIST)

Use the forms and instructions in this packet only if the following factors apply to your situation.

- √ You are the natural or adoptive grandparent or great grandparent of the minor child(ren), AND
- √ You want to get a court order allowing you visitation with the minor child(ren), AND
- The minor child(ren) resided (lived) in Arizona at least six months before you file the petition or you talked to a lawyer who advised you that you could pursue the case in Arizona AND one of the following is true:
 - The parents of the minor child(ren) have been divorced for at least three months, OR
 - One parent has been dead or missing for at least three months, OR
 - The minor child(ren) were born out of wedlock.

READ ME: Consulting a lawyer before filing documents with the court may help prevent unexpected results. Before you sign any court document, or get involved with a court case, it is important that you see a lawyer to make sure you are doing the right thing. Go to www.azbar.org for a list of court-approved lawyers.
