

PROCEDURES: HOW TO FILE LEGAL SEPARATION WITHOUT MINOR CHILDREN PAPERS WITH THE COURT

STEP 1: Complete the “Family Court Cover Sheet” and the “Confidential Sensitive Data Form. No copies needed. (File these in with your original documents.)

Make two (2) copies of the following documents after you have filled them out.

- “Summons”
- “Preliminary Injunction”
- “Petition for Legal Separation Without Minor Children”
- “Notice Regarding Creditors”

STEP 2: **SEPARATE YOUR DOCUMENTS INTO ONE SET of ORIGINALS and TWO SETS of COPIES.**

STEP 3: **FILE THE PAPERS AT THE COURT:** Take the original and all sets of copies to the Clerk of the Court filing counter. The clerk will keep the originals, stamp the extra copies to show that these are copies of papers you have filed with the court, and return the stamped (now called “conformed”) copies to you.

If you cannot or do not want to file the documents in person, you can also mail the documents to the Clerk of the Court. Provide a self-addressed, stamped envelope with proper postage so that the Clerk can return your “conformed” (stamped by Court staff) copies to you.

MAKE SURE YOU GET BACK THE FOLLOWING FROM THE CLERK:

- Your set of copies
- Your spouse’s set of copies

FEES: There are fees for filing petitions, responses, requests, motions, objections, and various forms with the Court. Cash, VISA/MasterCard debit or credit cards, money order, or personal in-state check made payable to the “Clerk of Superior Court” are acceptable forms of payment.
