NAME CHANGE FOR AN ADULT WITH NO MINOR CHILDREN (CHECKLIST)

Use the forms if the following factors apply to your situation:

- You are a resident of the county where you are filing this request.
- You want to ask the court to change your name, AND
- You are an adult 18 years or older, and you are not the parent of any minor children, AND
- You are prepared, under penalty of perjury, to inform the court whether you have ever been convicted of a felony, and whether there are any pending charges against you for a felony or other offense involving false statements or misrepresentation of identity, AND
- You understand the change of name will <u>neither</u> harm your rights <u>nor</u> release you from any obligations or liabilities incurred under your current name, AND
- You are not changing your name to that of another person for the purpose of committing any crime or furthering any offense involving fraud or misrepresentation of identity.

NOTE: You <u>do not need</u> to request a name change through the court if you get married and want to use your spouse's last name.
