CLAIM AGAINST THE ESTATE - CHECKLIST

Use the forms and instructions ONLY if the following factors apply to your situation:

 $\sqrt{}$ You received notice about a court case involving the property of a person who died (informal probate)

OR

 $\sqrt{}$ You believe a person who died owes you money, and you want to make a claim against the estate before all the property is transferred to others

AND

 $\sqrt{}$ The person had a will or did not have a will.
