WEISBERG, Judge Pro Tempore, in the Superior Court of Arizona in Mohave County in the manner provided in A.R.S. 12-141 through 12-144, for the period July 1, 1989, through December 31, 1989, to serve pursuant to written order of the Presiding Judge of the Juvenile Court and specifically provided that, notwithstanding any provisions of the law to the contrary, such Court Commissioner serving as Judge Pro Tempore shall receive no compensation or benefit, fiscal or otherwise, other than that to which he is entitled as Court Commissioner.
