ORDER

Pursuant to A.R.S. 8-202(c), the juvenile court has exclusive original jurisdiction over civil traffic violations committed within the county by persons under eighteen years of age unless the presiding judge of the county declines jurisdiction of such cases. Since the presiding judge may decline jurisdiction of civil traffic violations committed within the county by juveniles if it is determined that the declination would promote the more efficient use of limited judicial and law enforcement resources located within the county,

IT IS ORDERED that Mohave County limited jurisdiction judges and judges pro tempore shall have jurisdiction of civil traffic violations committed within the county by juveniles.
