
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
2002-26

The Mohave County court system is in need of additional judicial officers, on a part-time basis, who are Arizona residents and licensed to practice law in this state. Chief Justice Jones, for the Arizona Supreme Court, has recently adopted new sections of the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration to provide guidance for selection of judicial officers. Pursuant to the authority of that code,

IT IS ORDERED appointing Eric Devaney and Deborah Liverence as pro tem justices of the peace for part-time duties in relief of the elected justices of the peace, for weekend initial appearance proceedings or other proceedings as requested by the justices of the peace in Mohave County.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each of these appointments will expire on December 31, 2002. Applications for a longer term of service in this capacity will be subject to the Mohave County Committee on Special Judicial Appointments.
