

Bullhead City Justice Court will be in need of a justice of the peace pro tempore during the absence of Judge Brady during July, 2004, and none of our current pro tems are able to serve during the duration of Judge Brady's absence. The Arizona Supreme Court provides the service of a qualified special judicial officer for this sort of circumstance. He has agreed to serve in the Bullhead City Justice Court as needed.

IT IS ORDERED appointing Mr. Paul Julien as justice of the peace pro tempore, for a period of six (6) months, to serve in Bullhead City Justice Court during the absence of Justice of the Peace Thomas W. Brady, and as needed in any other justice court precinct, as needed and arranged by the particular court, during this six month period.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, in accordance with the arrangement made with the supreme court, Mohave County shall pay the appropriate lodging, mileage and meal per diem for Mr. Julien during that service.
