
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
2004-44

Bullhead City Justice of the Peace Thomas Brady has demonstrated a need for some additional special judicial officers to conduct initial appearance proceedings in criminal cases on weekends and holidays when no pro tempore judges are available. Those proceedings are held in the Bullhead City court facility on a regular basis. Judge Brady has proposed candidates who possess a combination of education and work experience which qualify them to conduct initial appearances. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED appointing Laura J. Billings and Daniel Meister as special initial appearance masters to conduct initial appearances on weekends, holidays or other days when no justice of the peace, magistrate or judge pro tempore is reasonably available. As required by Rule 1.7, Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure, assignment of duties to a special master shall be the exception and not the rule.

This appointment shall be for the period from this date through June 30, 2005.
