ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, Bullhead City Justice of the Peace Thomas Brady has demonstrated a continued need for an additional special judicial officer to conduct initial proceedings in criminal cases on weekends and holidays when no pro tempore judges are available. Those proceedings are held in the Bullhead City court facility on a regular basis. Under the authority granted by Rule 1.7, Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure, I find that there is a compelling reason to appoint a special master for the limited purpose of conducting initial appearances when neither a judge nor judge pro tem is available. Judge Brady has proposed a candidate who possesses a combination of education and work experience that qualifies him to conduct initial appearances. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED re-appointing Daniel Meister as special initial appearance master to conduct initial appearances when no justice of the peace, magistrate or judge pro tempore is reasonably available. As required by Rule 1.7, assignment of duties to this special master on the schedule shall be the exception and not the rule.

This re-appointment shall be for the period of July 1, 2005 through December 31, 2005.
