
Given the recent changes in Judicial assignment and after due consideration of the current case assignment process, it is necessary to revise the existing case assignments. The Judges have reviewed and agreed to the attached newly adopted case assignment schedule. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED adopting the procedures and schedule outlined in the accompanying Table and Guidelines as the procedure for assignment of cases to the judicial officers in the Mohave County Superior Court. Effective date of the changes is listed in the table and Administrative Order 2009-53 is rescinded, pursuant to the effective dates set forth herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that when a subsequent Domestic Relations case is filed between the same parties of an existing case, it will be assigned to the Judge with the oldest existing case number. Additionally when the assigned Judge for an Order of Protection is not available the matter will be referred to another Judge according to the following schedule:

- Lake Havasu City – Judge Davis, Judge Carlisle, Judge Jantzen
- Bullhead City – Judge Roth, Judge Carlisle, Judge Jantzen
- Kingman – Judge Jantzen, Judge Carlisle, Judge Williams

The above assignment of cases to judges according to cause numbers will NOT apply in either of the following 2 circumstances:

1. A change of plea has been set before a specific judge and the Information is to be filed immediately before the hearing. Such case will be assigned to the judge before whom the change of plea is set regardless of the cause number.
2. A case where a defendant already has a pending criminal case in the Superior Court (including being on probation). Such case will be assigned to the judge who has the earlier case, regardless of the cause number.

To whatever extent possible, when cases are assigned contrary to the assignment guidelines, the Clerk's Office will attempt to "balance the assignment" of later cases so that each judge is assigned cases according to the following guidelines:
