ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
2012-33

WHEREAS, the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Mohave County exercises administrative supervision over the Judicial Branch of Government in Mohave County;


WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 13-901(A), when granting probation or unsupervised probation in Superior Court to an adult, the court, as a condition of probation, shall assess a monthly fee of not less than sixty-five dollars unless, after determining the inability of the probationer to pay the fee, the court assesses a lesser fee;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration 6-206(G)(1)(b) requires the Probation Department to file a Petition and Order requesting the suspension of probation service fees for a period of time tolled as a result of an offender absconding from probation or for a period of time an offender was incarcerated for more than 30 days while on probation;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration 6-206(G)(2) requires the Probation Service Fees shall only be assessed for each month a probationer is on probation for one or more days, therefore, only complete months the offender is incarcerated or the time is tolled pursuant to the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration 6-206(G)(1)(b) shall be waived as petitioned by the probation department.

IT IS ORDERED, that effective July 13, 2012, upon receipt of a Petition and Order from the Probation Department requesting the suspension of probation service fees for a period of time tolled, excluding any period of time the offender was under direct supervision, as a result of an offender absconding from probation or for a period of time an offender was incarcerated for more than 30 days while on probation, the Court shall sign the same.
