As a Judge Pro Tempore she has agreed to donate part of her services, to the extent her compensation is less than the statutory salary for a superior court judge, in accordance with A.R.S. § 12-142 (C), and

**IT IS ORDERED** that upon approval of Chief Justice Robert Brutinel, Megan A. McCoy is appointed as a Judge Pro Tempore in the Superior Court in Mohave County for the period beginning August 3, 2019, through June 30, 2020.

PRO TEMPORE ORDER

The presiding judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Mohave County has requested the appointment of a judge pro tempore to assist that court with the processing of cases. Therefore, pursuant to Ariz. Const. Art. VI, § 31 and A.R.S. § 12-141 et seq.,

IT IS ORDERED that Megan A. McCoy, State Bar #024736, is appointed as a judge pro tempore to serve the Superior Court in Mohave County for a term beginning upon signature of this Order, and ending June 30, 2020.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the appointee shall perform judicial duties authorized by A.R.S. § 12-144 as assigned by the presiding judge. This appointment is conditioned upon the approval of the Mohave County Board of Supervisors pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-141, and upon the Superior Court in Mohave County obtaining appropriate funding from whatever source for any compensation due to said appointee pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-142(C) and A.R.S. § 12-143 for service as a judge pro tempore.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the appointee may perform duties of a judge authorized by A.R.S. § 25-121 et seq. and A.R.S. § 12-2222 without specific assignment by the presiding judge subject to agreement by the appointee to perform these duties without public compensation or benefits.
