
WHEREAS, there is a need to appoint a qualified person to serve during absences by judges in Mohave County Superior Court. Justice of the Peace David Wayt is a full-time justice of the peace, otherwise qualified to serve as a superior court judge pro tempore, and willing to assist the superior court by hearing cases on an occasional basis as assigned. In addition, during the annual judicial conference, and possibly during local continuing education programs, there may be occasions on which no superior court judges are available for emergency matters.

IT IS ORDERED that upon approval of Chief Justice Ann A. Scott Timmer, the following person is appointed as a Judge Pro Tempore in the Superior Court in Mohave County for a term beginning on July 1, 2025 and ending June 30, 2026:

IT IS ORDERED that David Wayt shall serve without compensation above his established salary as Justice of the Peace.
