Plaintiff is hereby notified that effective June 1, 2026, the Clerk of Court will no longer accept the filing of Certificates of Compulsory Arbitration with Civil case filings in accordance with Rule 72 of the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure - as those rules have been replaced by Rules 101 through 126 of the Rules for the FASTAR Program for all civil cases within the limits set forth in the FASTAR Program. Thus,

Effective June 1, 2026, Plaintiffs must file a FASTAR Certificate in accordance with Rule 102 of the FASTAR Program.

Plaintiff is hereby notified that if a FASTAR Certificate is not filed in accordance with 102 of the FASTAR Program within twenty (20) days of issuance of this notice, the case SHALL be dismissed without prejudice.
