Allocation of Victim Restitution Payments

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
2026 – 26

**WHEREAS** the Superior Court is responsible for ensuring that victim restitution payments are distributed in a fair, efficient, and consistent manner; and

**WHEREAS** clarification is necessary regarding the default method of allocating restitution payments among multiple victims or payees when no specific allocation is ordered by the sentencing court; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to ACJA § 3-401(D)(1), all private victims are paid before any institutional victims.


**IT IS ORDERED** that, unless a judicial officer expressly directs otherwise in a sentencing order, restitution payments made by a defendant shall be applied proportionately based on each victim's share of the restitution balance for that category of victim owed at the time of distribution.

For purposes of this Order, "proportionately" means that each victim or payee shall receive a percentage of any payment equal to their outstanding restitution amount divided by the total outstanding restitution owed to victims of that category (private or institutional) in that case.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that **Administrative Order 2006-007** is hereby **rescinded** in its entirety.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that this Administrative Order becomes effective immediately and shall remain in effect unless modified or rescinded by future order.
