This Court finds that it is necessary for the prompt disposition of the judicial business before the Juvenile Court Court make liberal use of a Juvenile Court Commissioner acting in the prompt capacity of a Judge Pro Tempore, without increase in salary, for necessary calendar control to rule on ex-parte motions, to hold hearings on contested matters and to do other judicial business of the Juvenile Court which might otherwise be excluded by his authority as a Juvenile Court Commissioner. Numerous occasions arise, including but not limited to those times Judges are on vacation, attending conferences and involved in other judicial proceedings which make use of the Juvenile Court Commissioner acting as a Judge Pro Tempore appropriate and necessary for the prompt disposition of the juvenile business of the Juvenile

In furtherance of these findings and in accordance with Supreme Court Orders and Administrative Orders of the Presiding Judge of Mohave County, it is

ORDERED, effective January 1, 1988 through June 30, 1983, appointing Juvenile Court Commissioner SHELDON H. WEISBERG as Judge Pro Tempore in order to conduct the judicial business of the Mohave County Juvenile Court, in whatever location this Court may be sitting, in the absence or unavailability of the Juvenile Court Judge of Mohave County.

ORDERED that when acting in the capacity of Judge Pro Tempore, the aforesaid Juvenile Court Commissioner shall not be entitled to receive and shall not receive any compensation other than his salary as Juvenile Court Commissioner.
