

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 8-232 and in the interest of clarifying the jurisdiction of justices of the peace and municipal courts over juvenile matters;

IT IS ORDERED that effective July 17, 1994, all Mohave County justices of the peace and city magistrates, including their respective judges pro tempore, are appointed juvenile hearing officers pursuant to A.R.S. § 8-232 et. seq. and may hear and determine juvenile violations of the laws relating to alcohol purchase, possession or consumption; boating or game and fish; curfew; truancy; possession of firearms; any city, town or political subdivision ordinance; provisions of the motor vehicle code not declared to be a felony; and civil traffic violations.


