ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
2006-007

Pursuant to the Superior Court Clerk's Victim Allocation Policy, restitution payments shall be allocated as follows:

IT IS ORDERED that where there is more than one victim, restitution payments shall be allocated and disbursed proportionately to the victims, except where any allocated payment would be less than \$5. In that event, a rotation of payments shall occur. The Clerk is first directed to pay the entire restitution payment received to the victim owed the most restitution. (It should be noted that the priority of restitution payments shall be to individuals first and then to business entities and corporations.) Thereafter, the next payment received will be paid by priority to the next victim owed the next greater restitution amount. After the victim(s) who are individuals are paid in full, the next payment received will then be paid to the business entity or corporation who is owed the most restitution. Thereafter, the next payment received will be paid to the next victim owed the next greater restitution amount, and such allocation shall continue until all restitution is paid in full.
