There is a need for a special judicial officer to conduct initial appearance proceedings for criminal cases in the Moccasin Justice Court, and under the authority granted by Rule 1.7, Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure, I find that there is a compelling reason to appoint a special master for the limited purpose of conducting initial appearances when neither a judge nor judge pro tem is available. Barbara Brown has a combination of education and work experience, from her position as Associate Magistrate for Colorado City, which qualifies her to conduct initial appearances.

IT IS ORDERED re-appointing Barbara Brown as special initial appearance master to conduct initial appearances when no justice of the peace, magistrate or judge pro tempore is reasonably available. As required by Rule 1.7, assignment of duties to this special master on the schedule shall be the exception and not the rule.

This re-appointment shall be effective until December 31, 2007.
