The judges of this court have reviewed the case assignment system adopted in 2005, and in view of some changed circumstances which are likely to persist for some time, it is advisable to make a modification to the schedule. The affected judges have been consulted and agreed to these changes, which will hopefully improve the case processing in our court.

IT IS ORDERED modifying the case assignment schedule adopted in Administrative Order 2005-15 as follows:

DOMESTIC RELATIONS (DO)

- 1. Cases filed in Lake Havasu City and given a 7000 number will be assigned to Judge Gurtler and heard in either Lake Havasu City or Bullhead City, depending on scheduling needs of the facilities and parties. Those cases proceeding to final hearing by default will be heard by Judge Pro Tempore Jill Davis, so long as she continues to serve in that capacity, but will remain officially assigned to Judge Gurtler for any post-decree proceedings.
- 2. Cases filed in Bullhead City and give a 4000 number will be assigned to Judge Gurtler and heard in Bullhead City to the extent possible.
- 3. Cases filed in Kingman and assigned a case number ending either in 5 or 0 will be assigned to Judge Gurtler and heard in Bullhead City to the extent possible.
- 4. All other cases filed in Kingman will be assigned to Commissioner/Judge Pro Tempore Roth and heard in Kingman.
