Additionally when the assigned Judge for an Order of Protection is not available the matter will be referred to another Judge according to the following schedule:

The above assignment of cases to judges according to cause numbers will NOT apply in either of the following 2 circumstances:

- 1. A change of plea has been set before a specific judge and the Information is to be filed immediately before the hearing. Such case will be assigned to the judge before whom the change of plea is set regardless of the cause number.
- 2. A case where a defendant already has a pending criminal case in the Superior Court (including being on probation). Such case will be assigned to the judge who has the earlier case, regardless of the cause number.

To whatever extent possible, when cases are assigned contrary to the assignment guidelines, the Clerk's Office will attempt to "balance the assignment" of later cases so that each judge is assigned cases according to the following guidelines:

Conn	-	9 of 20	(45%)
Carlisle	~	9 of 20	(45%)
Jantzen	-	2 of 20	(10%)
