## IN THE SUPERIOR COURT OF THE STATE OF ARPZONA IN AND FOR THE COUNTY OF MOHAVE VIRLYNN TINNELL SUPERIOR COURT CLERK ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER PROBATION TO INCLUDE DEFERRED INCARCERATION TIME IN THE SUPERIOR COURT CLERK ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2013-02

WHEREAS, the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Mohave County exercises administrative supervision over the Judicial Branch of Government in Mohave County;

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 13-901(F), When granting probation the court may require that the defendant be imprisoned in the county jail at whatever time or intervals, consecutive or nonconsecutive, the court shall determine, within the period of probation, as long as the period actually pent in confinement does not exceed one year or the maximum period of imprisonment permitted under chapter 7 of this title, whichever is the shorter.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration Part 6: Probation, Chapter 2: Adult Services, Section 6-207: Uniform Conditions of Supervised Probation, condition number 20 authorizes the sentencing judge to impose community restitution hours under the direction of the adult probation department and incarceration in the county jail at the discretion of the Court, upon recommendation from the adult probation department.

IT IS ORDERED, that effective February 1, 2013, that all offenders placed on supervised probation within the criminal division, excluding offenders ineligible for incarceration as sentenced pursuant to A.R.S. § 13-901.01, shall be ordered as a condition of Project SAFE to complete up to 200 community restitution hours (in addition to any ordered under condition #17), as directed by the adult probation department and serve up to 90 days in the county jail (in addition to any ordered under condition #18), at the discretion of the Court, upon recommendation from the APD. Further, that the APD is authorized to arrest and detain a probationer subject to incarceration pursuant to condition #20 prior to Court order, however, must file the Petition and Order requesting such within 24 hours for the Courts consideration.
