ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

NO. 2015-10

WHEREAS, the Mohave County Juvenile Court shall establish a Governance Board for the purposes of developing, implementing and overseeing the Crossover Youth Practice Model in Mohave County, Arizona consistent with the best practices as established by Georgetown University Center for Juvenile Justice Reform. The role of this Board shall be to provide oversight, accountability, fidelity and quality assurance for its community partners in providing Crossover Youth services to the children of Mohave County, Arizona.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED the Mohave County Crossover Youth Practice Model Governance Board shall generally consist of a representative or proxy from the following entities or organizations: the Presiding Juvenile Judge of Mohave County or designee Juvenile Court Judge; the Chief or Assistant Chief Probation Officer of the Juvenile Division of the Mohave County Probation Department; a supervisory level representative from Mohave County of the Arizona Department of Child Safety; the Managing Attorney of the Mohave County Legal Advocate's Office; a managerial level representative of a Behavioral / Mental Health service provider within Mohave County; an administrative representative from a School District within Mohave County; an experienced attorney in good standing from Mohave County that represents parents in Dependency cases; an administrative / supervisory representative from a Mohave County Law Enforcement Agency; a Deputy County Attorney assigned to process cases in Delinquency cases; an Assistant Attorney General assigned to process Dependency cases; At Large Members from such entities or organizations such as: CASA, Arizona Youth Partnership, Mohave County Administration, any other group that provides best practice service or support to Crossover Youth, a present or former delinquent or dependent child, a present or former parent of a delinquent or dependent child.

FURTHER ORDERED the Mohave County Crossover Youth Practice Model Governance Board shall consist of no less than five (5) nor more than fifteen (15) members.

FURTHER ORDERED terms of service on the Mohave County Crossover Youth Practice Model Governance Board shall commence on the date of appointment for a minimum of one (1) year, unless otherwise noted membership shall last so long as the member remains in good standing with his or her organization. The Governance Board shall develop procedures and criteria for the recruitment and retention of Board members.

FURTHER ORDERED the Mohave County Crossover Youth Governance Board shall meet as often as necessary, provided the Board meets at least quarterly.

FURTHER ORDERED members of the Mohave County Crossover Youth Governance Board shall actively participate as needed to assist in the development, implementation, fidelity and oversight of services and programs for the Crossover Youth of Mohave County.
