WHEREAS, Administrative Order No. 2017-15 of the Supreme Court of Arizona, adopted Court Security Standards as set forth in the Court Security Standards Committee final report issued in December 2016. Those standards involve the creation of a countywide Security and Emergency Preparedness Committee (SEPC). The Standards provide that the function of the countywide SEPC includes, but is not limited to, setting goals for implementation of the court security standards, review of the local security plans and self-assessments, coordination of security needs countywide, support procurement of funding for security measures and ensuring a program of continuous court security improvement.

IT IS ORDERED, establishing the Security and Emergency Preparedness Committee effective September 15, 2017.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, the individuals listed on that attached sheet are appointed as members of the countywide SEPC for a period of two years. The Presiding Judge may appoint additional members and extend the terms of the current members as may be necessary.
