WHEREAS, there exists a need to have the assistance of an additional commissioner to assist with emergency matters or cases that cannot be handled in a timely manner and


WHEREAS, Article 6, Section 24 of the Arizona Constitution provides that judges of the superior court may appoint court commissioners . . . in their respective counties, who shall have such powers and perform such duties as may be provided by law or by rule of the supreme court,

WHEREAS, the Arizona Supreme Court issued order R-21-0044 on November 23, 2021, amending the Rules of the Supreme Court to include Rule 96(j), which created the position of Senior Commissioner, if approved by the Chief Justice.

WHEREAS, Chief Justice Robert M. Brutinel has approved the appointment of Richard Weiss, as a Senior Commissioner.

IT IS ORDERED that Richard Weiss is appointed as a Senior Commissioner to assist with pending protective orders, guardianships and conservatorships, mental health, family law, juvenile, civil and criminal matters effective June 20, 2022.
